## 3. Any Other Business

i. The Director of Music and Head of Chapel Office agreed and the Committee noted that this would be offered moving forward.
ii. Concert pricing for students: Mr Alex Carter raised that for the Choir's forthcoming performance of Monteverdi Vespers events there are no student ticket prices being offered. The Director of Music noted that student discounts are ordinarily offered for selfpromoted Choir events, but on this occasion the combination of the expense involved in this particular concert and the Hall's limited audience capacity resulted in the need to try and make the concert as profitable as possible. It was agreed that ticket sales would be reviewed 10 days before the event, and that the Dress

Rehearsal on the day would be open to Clare students to attend free of charge.
