Contamination from COVID 19	Everyone attending, contamination from COVID 19.	Wearing of face coverings by all those attending a place of worship, including ministers, worshippers and the Choir , where there may be other people present will be continue to be encouraged. There are exemptions to this, including for those leading a service and those with health, disability or other conditions.	Disposable face coverings to be available.	All	1 October 2020
