Risk: Transmission of Covid-19 via equipment	Players could be at risk of contracting COVID-19		<p>Equipment is sanitised before and after each session (e.g. balls)</p> <p>In drills that are specifically focused on throwing / heading, sanitise the ball before and after the drill</p> <p>Each participants' belongings will be kept off the pitch 2 m apart from others</p> <p>Individuals bring their own labelled hand sanitiser to sessions. Risk: Transmission of Covid-19 via facilities at the college sports ground	Players could be at risk of contracting COVID-19		Players must follow the one-way system in the Pavilion Players must spray the toilet seat before and after use We will avoid use of the Pavilion, except to use the toilet and changing facilities When using the toilet, only one person should enter at a time. Others should queue socially distanced outside the Pavilion. When entering to use changing facilities/ toilets players should avoid bottlenecks – doors are single use to avoid congestion.
