<p><b>Contamination from COVID 19</b></p>	<p>Everyone attending, contamination from COVID 19.</p>	<p>Detailed instructions on ‘consumables’ suggest that services of Holy Communion can be held if specific guidance is followed, including the continued suspension of the Common C</p>				
<p><b>Contamination from COVID 19</b></p>	<p>Everyone attending, contamination from COVID 19.</p>	<p>Following a service the Chapel should be cleaned by housekeeping prior to the next services</p>				
<p><b>Contamination from COVID 19</b></p>	<p>Everyone attending, contamination from COVID 19.</p>	<p>Wearing of face coverings by all those attending a place of worship, including ministers and worshippers, where there may be other people present is <b>mandatory</b>. There are exemptions to this, including for those leading a service.</p>				

<p><b>Contamination from COVID 19</b></p>	<p>Everyone attending, contamination from COVID 19 from touching surfaces.</p>	<p>Refreshments can only be served at tables if a café is included in the church or cathedral building</p>				
<p><b>Contamination from COVID 19</b></p>	<p>Everyone attending, contamination from COVID 19 from touching surfaces.</p>	<p>2 meter social distancing should be maintained at all times. The seating area in the Chapel should be clearly marked to ensure social distancing can be maintained.</p>
