Regarding alumni based work experience placements over 40 alumni responded with offers of nearly 50 placements. It is anticipated that the majority of these will not take place but one company will be hosting seven students remotely running education courses and providing insight into how the company is run and specific roles within the organisation. It has not been possible to award the Hammond Clare Development Awards for career-related activities the previous year as the applications received were all for future work. These applications will be reassessed after summer if work has taken place otherwise the funds will be used for other purposes within the College. The annual Jakobi Human Rights Prize was awarded to Parvathi Subbiah.
