Ellie is the Assistant Director of Music at All Saints Church, Putney. She was the organ scholar at Tewkesbury Abbey and Dean Close School from 2019-2020, and is also a recent Music graduate from Clare College, Cambridge. There she held the post of the Sir William McKie Senior Organ Scholar, the first ever female organ scholar in Clare College's history.

Ellie has given organ recitals and performed at various venues, such as St. Lawrence Jewry in London, Buxton Music festival and Truro Cathedral, as well as internationally, including at Notre-Dame Cathedral. In Cambridge, Ellie gave organ recitals at King's College, Clare College, St. John's College, Queen's College, Girton College, Sidney Sussex College and Pembroke College, where she performed as part of Pembroke's all female Bachathon, as well as being selected for a masterclass with Dame Gillian Weir.

As part of her organ scholarship at Clare, Ellie played for the Choir's regular schedule of services and concerts, including tours of Europe and North America, also occasionally directing the Choir. Ellie has performed on three of their professional CD recordings, as organist and choir member, and has played live on BBC Radio 3, on the 'In Tune' live broadcast. Ellie also accompanied the King's Voices Choir of King's College, Cambridge for two years. In her second year, she completed her ARCO, and was awarded the Dr John Birch Scholarship. Also in her second year, Ellie was the President of Clare College Music Society, where she led a committee throughout the year. In her third year, she won the Cambridge University Brian Runnett competition for organ playing, and she won College prizes for contribution to music.

As well as music, Ellie works full time for Feefo, a ratings and reviews company, as one of their Customer Success Directors.
